# INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON AUDIT OF QUARTERLY AND ANNUAL STANDALONE FINANCIAL RESULTS

### TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF AVANTEL LIMITED

### **Opinion**

We have audited the accompanying standalone quarterly financial results of **AVANTEL LIMITED** (the company) for the quarter ended 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023 and the year to date results for the period from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").
